

1. Be Earth conscious—**DON'T LITTER OR DAMAGE PLANT LIFE**
2. Disc Golf is played like ball golf, using a flying disc. One stroke is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The golfer with the lowest score wins.
3. Tee throws must be made from behind the designated tee areas.
4. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole throws first. The player with the least amount of strokes on the previous hole is first to tee off on the next hole.
5. Fairway throws must be made with a foot directly behind where the last throw landed. The other foot may be closer to the hole than this lie.
6. A run-up and normal follow through, after release, is allowed if more than 10 meters from the hole. Inside 10 meters, a player may not step past the lie until after the disc thrown has come to rest.
7. A disc that comes to rest inside the Disc Pole Hole® basket or chains constitutes successful completion of that hole. A disc that comes to rest on top of the Pole Hole does **NOT** constitute a successful putt.
8. Any disc that comes to rest 2 meters above the ground is considered unplayable and must be thrown from the ground directly below the disc. 1 throw penalty
9. A throw that lands out-of-bounds— must be played from the point where the disc went out-of-bounds. The park road, along side #18 is OB.
10. The creek on #15 is considered a water hazard, and players must take one stroke and move their disc to a legal lie.
11. Never throw until the players ahead of you are out of range, and until the fairway is completely clear of spectators and park guests.


